 - a. What are your initial impressions of these verses?
 - b. What parts are easy to understand and accept?
 - c. What parts do you struggle to understand or agree with?
- 3. Who are you in this parable? Why do you think so?
- 4. If you were one of the servants in the parable inviting people to the party, what would you say to entice them to accept the invitation?
- 5. What's your biggest takeaway from the parables of the wedding feast?
- 6. Think back through the Summer Stories series. How have Jesus' parable affected you?
