



Week 5: Fresh Breath for Dry Bones

The brokenness in this world has a way of wearing down our faith. It's not uncommon for spiritual vibrancy to give way to spiritual apathy. But God can breathe life into the dry places. He wants to see you hope again. Worship again. Love again. There's nothing in your life that can't be resurrected by you plus the Holy Spirit. Revival is simply a breath away.

Discussion Questions:

1. Describe a time in your life when you felt like your faith was the most vibrant. What were some of the contributing factors? Now talk about a time when you felt like you were spiritually dry? What do you think contributed to this? How did you come out of this "valley of dry bones"?
2. Read the following passages: Genesis 2:7; Job 33:4; John 6:63; Romans 8:2, 6, 10-11; 1 Corinthians 15:45; 2 Corinthians 3:6; Galatians 6:8. What do these verses tell us about the Holy Spirit?
3. If the Spirit brings life, and the Spirit of God is living in those of us who have surrendered to Jesus, what does this mean for us and how should we live in light of this truth?
4. Are there any areas of your life right now that need reviving (ex: marriage, parenting, career, relationships, faith, etc)? God's ready to perform a resurrection, but like Ezekiel, he expects us to participate. What role do you think you play in reviving these areas of your life?
5. What's the biggest learning from this message series that you will carry with you?
6. Close by praying for spiritual revival for your group and for Center Pointe, that we would be a people and a church fully alive in, and fully dependent on, the Holy Spirit.
