



Week 1: The Covenant Continues

God made promises to Abraham and he was not only faithful to those promises, but His faithfulness continued to the next generation – Isaac. In Genesis 24, we see God’s faithfulness through the lives and actions of two people who made choices to live in faithful, covenant love. Like them, we can choose to walk in covenant faithfulness and be people through whom the faithfulness of God reaches those around us.

Discussion Questions:

1. Think back on the last five years of your life. What are some of the small (perhaps “coincidental”) ways that you can now see God’s faithfulness?
2. Take some time to share stories of God’s faithfulness in your life. How has God been at work, even when you were not aware he was being faithful to you?
3. How do we avoid being wrapped up in the feeling in order to be faithful in the little things? What could you do this week to start a little habit of covenant faithfulness?
4. Have you ever thought about your choices being ways for God to be faithful through you? What might that thought change about your daily habits or choices? Looking back, how has God been faithful through you or through someone you know?
