



Week 1: God is Still Good & He Is Still Faithful

Through Joseph's story, we see how God works behind the scenes, using both triumphs and struggles to fulfill His purposes. We are reminded that, like Joseph, we can trust in God's promises and remain faithful, knowing that He is with us. God has a plan, and His timing is perfect. Discussion Questions:

1. How have you experienced God's faithfulness during a challenging time in your life?
2. What are some specific promises from Scripture that you turn to when you face uncertainty?
3. What is an example of a time when you saw God's hand at work in a challenging situation, even if it wasn't obvious at the time?
4. In what ways do you personally connect with God? Do you find worship, prayer, or another practice most effective for you?
5. How can we, as a small group, support each other in remembering God's goodness and faithfulness, particularly when life's circumstances are challenging?
6. Pray together as a group, asking God for the strength to hear His voice clearly, especially in times of failure, and to reaffirm your identity as sons and daughters of God.
7. What is one specific action step you feel led to take after today's discussion? How can the group pray for you or support you in this?
