



Week 9: Family Reunion

Genesis 46 is the emotional and long-awaited reunion between Jacob and Joseph. Whether you're facing a broken relationship, a major life decision, or the weight of grief, this story encourages us to seek God's wisdom first and trust His greater plan. Just as Joseph's faith and obedience brought restoration to his family, we're reminded of the ultimate reunion promised to us through the resurrection of Jesus—a reunion of hope, healing, and eternal joy.

Discussion Questions:

1. What's your favorite thing about family reunions? If you don't have them, who is one person you haven't seen in a long time that you would love to see again and why?
2. In **Genesis 46:1**, Jacob stops at Beer-sheba to worship God. Why do you think he paused before heading to Egypt, and what does this say about his growth in faith?
3. Read **James 1:5-8**. What does it mean to seek God's wisdom rather than worldly wisdom? How do you know when you're truly trusting God's guidance?
4. Jacob's story shows us the importance of worshipping and waiting on God's wisdom before making big decisions. How do you approach major decisions in your life? What might need to change?
5. The reunion between Joseph and Jacob is an emotional, powerful moment of redemption. How does this foreshadow the ultimate reunion and redemption we have in Christ? How can the promise of a future reunion with Jesus and loved ones impact the way you live today?
6. Close your time by sharing prayer requests and then pray for each other.
