## Week 10: Kingdom OS

In Mark 10, Mark records three different teaching moments that challenge us to realign our lives with the values and principles of the Kingdom and rediscover what it truly means to follow Jesus. In a world that runs on power and wealth, Jesus introduces us to a new way of operating by embracing a life of humility and surrender.

### Discussion Questions:

1. The Kingdom of God has an operating system of humility and surrender. How does this contrast with the world's operating system of power and wealth? In what ways do you find yourself operating by the world's system rather than the Kingdom's system?
2. **Read Mark 10:1-9.** How does Jesus' response challenge the cultural understanding of marriage? How does adopting a Kingdom OS help us honor the commitment in our own marriages? In what ways do you see God's design for marriage as a reflection of His relationship with us?
3. **Read Mark 10:13-16.** Why did Jesus use children as an example of how we should approach the Kingdom of God? What are ways we can invest in and disciple the next generation, both in our families and in the church?
4. **Read Mark 10:17-31.** The rich young man asked, "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" What does this reveal about his understanding of salvation? Why do you think Jesus told him to sell everything and follow Him? Do you think Jesus asks this of everyone? Why or why not? What things in your life might be keeping you from fully surrendering to Jesus?
5. How can you intentionally live with humility and surrender this week? Take time to pray for each other, asking God to reveal areas where you may need to shift from the world's operating system to the Kingdom's.
