ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, tell them about a time when you saw them be resourceful and how much you admire that.



Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: “What are some abilities, wisdom, or opportunities you’ve been given that you can use to point people to God?”



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “What are some things you feel like you are good at?” (If they need help, tell them some.)



Bed Time

Pray for each other: “God, show us the talents You have given us, and help us to use those to point people to You—whatever they are. Help us be creative in how we do that.”
