ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

Drive Time

Bath Time

Add toy food items, a bowl, mixing spoons, cups—all the cooking things—to bath time. As you pretend to cook together, talk about how God gives us people to help us, like God gave Moses his brother Aaron and friend Hur to help him.
