ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! No matter what we do today, I know God will help us."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, helping others is a big thing you have given us to do. Please help [child's name] and me look for ways we can help others."



Drive Time

While on the go, take turns saying this sentence: "One time, I helped [person's name] by [how you helped them]." Talk about how God helped a woman named Deborah help a lot of people.



Bath Time

During bath, play "Big or Little." Say: "Is an airplane big or little? Yes, an airplane is big! Is an ant big or little? Yes, an ant is little." Continue playing. Then say: "The things we do can be big, like going to school, cleaning our room, and saying we're sorry. God helps us do big things!"
