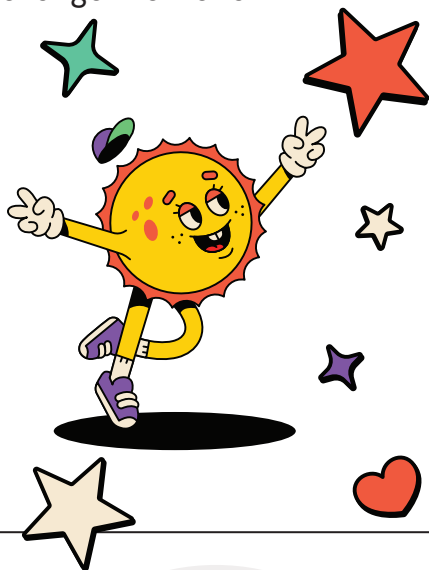

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, tell them something you saw them say or do lately that you admire.



Meal Time

Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "Who is someone who has encouraged you lately?" (It can be big or small.)
