

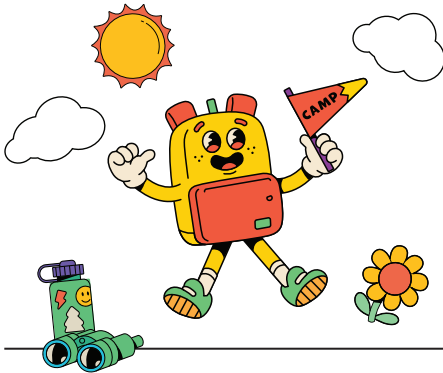
# Jesus shows me how to love others.

# Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER

## Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Rise and shine! It's a new day filled with lots of ways we can love like Jesus!"



## Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, I pray that [child's name] and I will be peacemakers, not peace breakers. As far as it depends on us, help us do what we can to live in peace with one another."



## Drive Time

While on the go, name different actions and decide together if they are being a peacemaker or a peace breaker. (For example, sharing a toy and taking a toy away from someone.) Talk about how Barnabas was a peacemaker by helping his friends become friends with Paul.



## Bath Time

During bath time, say: "I'm going to show you how to bathe yourself!" Continue to say the word "show" as often as possible as you show your child how to wash their hair, body, put away what they use, and dry off. End by saying: "Who shows you how to love others? Jesus shows me how to love others!"
