

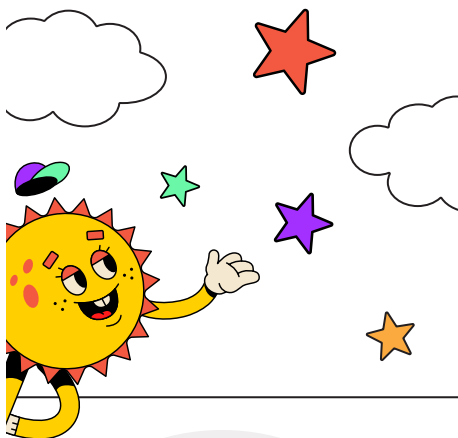

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! It's time to wake up and make it a great day! Give me a high five if you can do what Jesus says!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, it is so special that Jesus prayed for everyone who would follow Him. That means Jesus prayed for us! Please help [child's name] and me remember that we will always have Jesus as our Friend."



Drive Time

While on the go, think of people you can pray for. Each time a person is named, pray for them right then. How many people can you pray for before you get where you're going?



Bath Time

As you help your child bathe, sing the following words together to the tune of "Mary Had a Little Lamb": "I can pray for [name], [name], [name]! I can pray for [name] and do what Jesus says!" Repeat with as many people as you can think of.
