

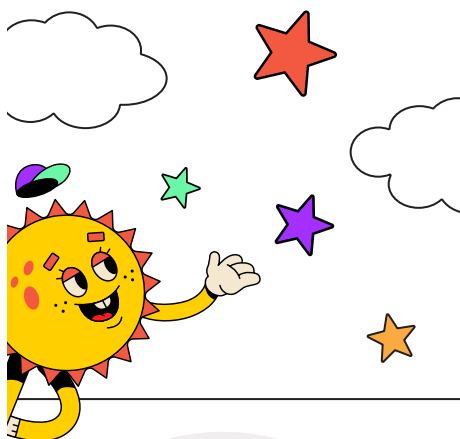
I can do what Jesus says.

Weekly Parent Cues



Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! What are some things Jesus wants us to do today? Jesus says to forgive others, pray for others, care for others, and teach others to do what Jesus says. We can do that!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, thank You that we know Your Son, Jesus. Please help [child's name] and me do what Jesus says and help all people follow Jesus. We love You, God!"



Drive Time

While on the go, talk about important things you have done, like celebrating a family member/friend, sharing with someone, etc. Talk about how Jesus told us to do something else VERY important. Jesus said to go and teach all people to do what Jesus says.



Bath Time

Place toy friends around the tub. Give your child a friend to walk around the tub to each friend and say: "Jesus loves you! You can follow Jesus and do what Jesus says!" Talk about how Jesus wants us to tell all people about Him and teach them to do what Jesus says.
