



Discussion Questions:

1. Jonah's response to God's call was initially to run away. Have you ever sensed God leading you toward something that you resisted or avoided? What was holding you back?
2. Jonah obeyed God outwardly but didn't share God's heart for Nineveh. Have you ever found yourself doing the right thing outwardly, but internally your heart wasn't aligned with God's? What happened?
3. Jonah cared more about his comfort than the lives of the people in Nineveh. In what areas of your life might comfort or convenience be hindering your ability to truly care for and reach out to others?
4. The story emphasizes that God's character remains compassionate and gracious even when we run. How does this truth impact your willingness to return to God when you realize you've gone your own way?
5. Jonah's story ends unresolved, with a challenging question from God. Why do you think the story concludes this way, and how does it speak to your own life and choices?
6. Where do you sense God asking you to go deeper or step out of your comfort zone right now, and what practical step can you take this week to respond to that invitation?
