ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, remind them they can trust God even when something happens they don't understand.



Meal Time

One of the ways we trust God for things we don't understand is by remembering the things we do understand or experience. At a meal this week, have everyone share about a time when they learned or experienced how good God is.



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "What is something you don't understand that you wish you did?"
