ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Guess who loves you? (listen to all the guesses) You're right! All of those people love you. And God loves you too! God loves you so, so, so much!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, You love [child's name] so much, and You have good things for them to do. Please help [child's name] see the good things and do them."



Drive Time

While on the go, look for things that grow in a garden. (flowers, fruits, vegetables, herbs, trees, etc.) Talk about how God had good things for Adam and Eve to do, like work and care for the garden, and God has good things for us to do too.



Bath Time

Add toy fruits and vegetables and toy garden tools to bath time. Encourage your child to pretend they are working in a garden, while they take a bath. Talk about how working in a garden was part of God's plans for Adam and Eve.
