ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, share with them a time you saw them stand up for someone.



Meal Time

Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "Have you ever had someone stand up for you, or you stood up for someone else?"



Bed Time
