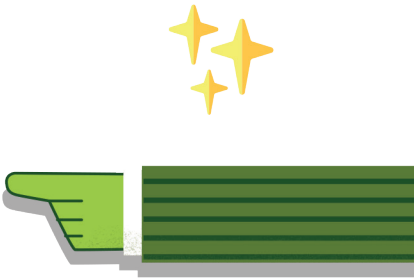
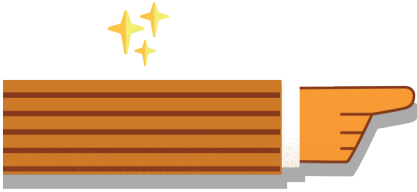

Bible Story

Moses and the Sea

Exodus 13:17-18; 14

Moses leads God's people to trust what God says, and God makes a path through the Red Sea for the Israelites to walk on.



Weekly Cues



Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning! Raise your hand if God loves you. (Raise your hand.) That's right! God loves me, and God loves [name of child]!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, You know everything. You love us, and You always tell the truth. [Name of child] and I can always trust what You say."



Drive Time

While on the go, look for things that are wet or carry water (rain, puddle, lawn sprinkler, fire hydrant, lake, water hose, fire truck, etc.) and things that are dry (which could be just about anything). Talk about how God made a dry path right through the wet Red Sea for Moses and the Israelites to walk on.



Bath Time

Add lots of bubbles to bath time. Show your child how to part the bubbles with their hands. While your child parts the bubbles, talk about how God parted the Red Sea to make a dry path for Moses and the Israelites to walk on.
