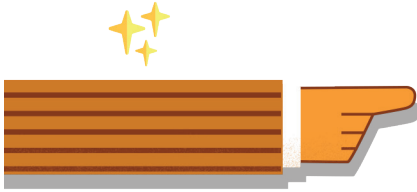

Jonah

Weekly Cues



Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! It's another day to do what God says because God knows what's best for us."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You for loving us and wanting what is best for us. Help us remember that You love everyone in the world and You want what is best for them too."



Drive Time

While on the go, say, "God knows what's best for [name of person]." Each time you say it, take turns choosing a different person's name. When you get home, end by saying, "God knows what's best for everyone!"



Bath Time

Add several different colors of toy fish to bath time. Play a game where you call out a color and your child has to find that color fish. When you're done playing, talk about how God sent a really big fish to keep Jonah safe.
